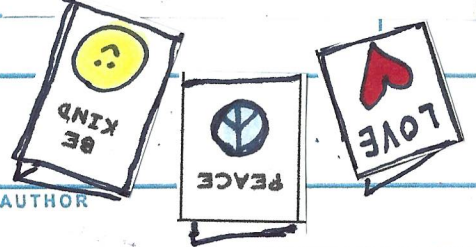


your library might have a special display of books by theme especially around seasons, special days or holidays



**nonfiction books** are organized by subject

each subject has a **call number** (for example: books about sharks are in section 597.3)

within each subject the books are organized in **alphabetical order** by the **author's last name**.

the call number is on the book **spine**

**fiction books** are separated into two main areas

**picture books** & **chapter books** then organized in **alphabetical order** by the **author's last name**

all books are either **fiction** - or **invented** from the author's imagination

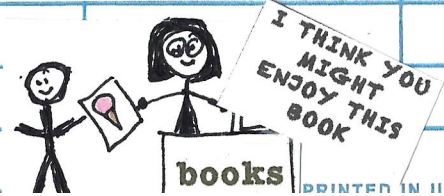
books that are about **facts** or **real events**
